MEET THE TEACHERS

Tomi Sue Pollock, DFCCA (Graded Syllabus) is a Diploma Fellow of the CCA. She also is the recipient of the Diploma Certificate from the ISTD, Cecchetti Society of England. Tomi has been a frequent guest faculty member of the CCA International Summer School and CCA Committee workshops. She received her Cecchetti and ballet training from Doris Dieu, Pamela Moore, Meredith Bayliss, Gwen Ashton, Anthony Valdor, Nina Popova, and Alexander Bennett. She has held the positions of Treasurer and Recording Secretary for the Greater St. Louis Committee and is currently the liaison to the Southeast Committee. Tomi currently resides in Troy, IL, where she is the director of The Dance Studio and director of the company, The Impact Dancers. She performed with the Mid America Dance Company, MadCo, and as guest artist with the Gateway Ballet.

Leslie Wood, DFCCA (*Graded Syllabus*) received her early training in Ann Arbor, MI from Sylvia Hamer, a founding member of the Cecchetti Council of America. She studied at the Royal Ballet School

in London, England for a year and at various studios in New York City. She performed with the Ann Arbor Civic Ballet and the Kearney Civic Ballet of which she was founder and director. Leslie has taught in New York City as well as many cities across the United States. She has worked with the Nebraska Arts Council and served as team leader for the Nebraska Department of Education's Visual and Performing Arts Frameworks Project. She is on the Board of Examiners of the Cecchetti Council of America and serves as Co-Principal of the International Cecchetti Council of America Teacher's Seminar She continues her training by attending dance workshops and conferences. She has also studied kinesiology for dancers and athletes. Leslie loves working with dancers of all ages and she is "always dedicated to proper training".

Sarah Ford Hardy (Jazz) is originally from Louisville, Kentucky and is a graduate of the Youth Performing Arts School. Sarah has also trained at the Joel Hall Dance Center and Columbia College in Chicago, IL, the Edge Performing Arts Center in Hollywood, CA and Millennium Dance Complex in Los Angeles. She has performed with numerous dance companies such as Inaside Chicago Dance, Midwest Dance Collective, DanceWerks Dance Productions, The Joel Hall Dancers and The JADD Co. Sarah has had the pleasure of sharing the stage with artists such as Weird Al Yankovic, Soulja Boy, Hannah Ford Welton and Joshua Welton of Counter Culture, 3rd Eye Girl and Prince. She was a member of the Joseph Allen Decker Dance Company where she assisted Mr. Decker for two seasons. She was a featured dancer in the movie *Dreams* and is the choreographer and a dancer for The Prince Experience out of Milwaukee, Wl. She is currently residing in Illinois where she is training, teaching and choreographing all over the Chicago area. This is Sarah's eighth season with Inaside Chicago Dance and her fifth year as a Company Member and the Youth Training Program Director.

Suzy Crawford (Zumba) started her journey in fitness 12 years ago when she taught Aqua Aerobics for the YWCA. In 2006, she discovered Zumba, a mix of low-intensity and high-intensity moves for an interval-style, calorie-burning dance fitness party. She was the first Zumba instructor in the Chicago area. She is also nationally certified to teach Pilates and works as a personal trainer at Evanston Athletic Club.
